 - Can add more sites to system
 - Overlay will be seamless
 - System will allow for limited state-state communications
 - Master site is directly connected to some sites

Conversion

- P25 master site installed in Becker Hansen
- Smart x adapters installed to convert P25 back to smart zone
- Astro smart zone is the vulnerable piece that needs replacement
- All new radios will need to be programmed as Smartzone
- Motorola should not include support in contract for radios
- State radio upgrades are a big hurdle to second phase for upgrade
- Best case scenario move to 2nd phase of project in 5 years
- It's suggested council recommend state agencies

Lewis- it is suggested to modify proposal for 2011-2015

Christenson seconds motion to suggest secretaries/Gov address radio purchases in annual budget.
